



Life Cover Claims - 2017

Life Cover pays a lump sum to your family or other beneficiaries if you die. It is the simplest form of protection available and it is usually taken out to provide for your family or to pay off your mortgage in the event of death.

In 2017, Zurich paid €39.6 million in death claims with an average payout of approximately €94,000.

At Zurich, 40% of claims were for people aged 60 or less.


Cancer is the principle cause of death - it accounted for nearly half of Zurich death claims in 2017.

Cancer and heart related deaths accounted for 61% of all death claims in 2017.



Heart related illnesses account for **29% of male** claims with Zurich yet for females, it's only **12%**.


At Zurich, cancer accounts for 61% of all Serious Illness claims.

Personal Accident Cover Claims - 2017

If you are self-employed, an accident could very quickly impact on your earnings. **Personal Accident Cover from Zurich** is designed to help you by paying a **weekly benefit** should you be unable to work in your current job due to an accident.

In 2017, Zurich paid out an average of almost €2,400 to customers that had suffered an accident and had been unable to work.




